

# **VOTER TIPS FOR RETURNING MICHIGAN ABSENTEE BALLOTS BY MAIL**



Ensure you affix first class postage before mailing your return ballot.



#### **GREEN RETURN BALLOT**

Ensure you are mailing only the green return envelope. Do not return your ballot in the blue envelope you received it in.



#### OFFICIAL ELECTION MAIL LOGO

Look for the official USPS Election Mail logo. The logo can only be used by federal, state and local government voter registration and election officials.



### **SEAL THE ENVELOPE**

Sealing the envelope helps secure your ballot from tampering and damage.



#### SIGN BEFORE MAILING

Your ballot must be signed or it will not be counted. Ensure include the date signed. You may have someone assist you if you are unable to sign. If someone assists you, ensure their name and address are printed below the signature box.

person who assists an absent voter and knowingly makes a false statement is guilty of a felony.

Keep your ballot secure.
It is a falony for anyone to be in possession of an absent voter ballot except authorized election officials, employees of postal services or other common earriers during the normal course of their job handling mail, or a member of the voter's immediate family or household who the absent voter has esked to return the ballot.
